PROGRAM IN DETAIL

DAY 01

ARRIVE - NAIROBI

Arrival at JKIA Airport where you will be met by HTT Operations Manager, a short safari brief and hand you to your driver guide then transferred by private vehicle to Ibis Styles Hotel, located in the heart of Westlands, Nairobi's commercial, retail and entertainment suburb about 20 kilometers from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. The hotel provides easy access to the city center and diplomatic district a perfect base to explore Kenya's capital while staying for business or leisure.

Lunch and dinner on own basis



Meal plan: Bed and Breakfast

DAY 02 NAIROBI - ABERDARES NATIONAL PARK

0830 hrs Buffet breakfast at Ibis Styles Hotel, Nairobi

0930 hrs Depart after breakfast for Aberdare National Park.

1230 hrs Arrival for lunch at Aberdare Country Club which is the base hotel for the Ark

Afternoon transfer to The Ark.

(Pack small overnight bags for the Ark).

Set in the heart of the Aberdare National Park, iconic and yes, quirky. The Ark overlooks a floodlit waterhole and salt lick, which attracts a host of awesome wildlife. Modeled after Noah's Ark, The Ark has four viewing decks with balconies and lounges to provide superb game viewing from the comfort of the lodge. The animals come to you!



Dinner and then overnight at the Ark.

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 03 ABERDARES NATIONAL PARK – LAKE NAIVASHA

0730 hrs Buffet breakfast at the Ark

0900 hrs Transfer to Aberdare Country Club to collect left luggage before departure for Lake Naivasha

We will visit Thomson's falls on our way to Lake Naivasha, Thomson's falls view is out of this world;

1300 hrs Arrival at Lake Naivasha Country Club in time for lunch

Afternoon spent at leisure.

Lake Naivasha is a freshwater lake in the Kenya section of Africa's Great Rift Valley, and is located North West of Nairobi with the town of Naivasha on its north eastern shore. At 1,890 meters (6,200 ft) above sea level, the lake is at the highest point in the Kenyan rift, and is set in a complex geological combination of volcanic rocks and sedimentary deposits from a much larger Pleistocene era lake.

Because the outlet for this ancient lake, now called Njorwa Gorge, is today much higher than the lake, the original Lake Naivasha must have indeed been a truly vast expanse of water. The gorge now forms the entrance to the Hell's Gate National Park which, for obvious reasons, today contains some spectacular examples of water and weather-worn rock formations as well as an abundance of flora and fauna to include some extremely rare, resident breeding pairs of Lammergeyers, otherwise known as Bearded vultures.

This time can be used doing a boat ride or a visit to Crescent Island – see rates below.

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 04 LAKE NAIVASHA - MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

0630hrs: Wake up to an early buffet breakfast at Lake Naivasha Country Club.

0730hrs –Depart for Masai Mara National Reserve, which is also known as the “**Jewell of Kenya**”. On your way to Masai Mara National Reserve, you will enjoy different array of views which are just priceless.

1230hrs appx: Arrive at Masai Mara National reserve; you will have game drive enroute to your lodge which is Mara Simba lodge

1530 hrs - enjoy your first game drive in this amazing game reserve known for its wildlife.

A spectacle worth seeing is the annual migration of millions of wildebeests, zebra, and gazelles from the Serengeti plains across the Tanzania border and Mara River to reach Maasai Mara grazing fields. The dramatic crossing of the river and the preying on the migrants by predators can be viewed early June to August. The Mara has got also thousands of species of bird life and plant life.



1830 hrs Return to the Lodge for dinner and then overnight at Mara Simba Lodge

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 05; WHOLE DAY AT MAASAI MARA NATIONAL PARK

00630hrs: Wake up for a refreshing hot cup of coffee or tea. Then depart for a morning game drive to explore the Mara plains and its intriguing wildlife.

Alternatively:-

You can opt for a Hot Air Balloon Safari instead of a morning game drive. This is truly a fun and exciting way to see Africa's landscapes and wildlife.



The trip is magical: spend about one hour floating over the Mara plains. You float in the sky, drift with the whim of the wind, overlooking the plains, just in time to experience a breathtaking sunrise and catch a bird's eye view of the reserve.

BALLOON SAFARI IS BOOKED AT EXTRA COST AS SHOWN BELOW IN OUR EXTRAS. The cost includes Balloon Safari + Out of Africa Bush Breakfast. A certificate will be presented by the pilot after the ride.

0830hrs: Return to the Lodge for a full buffet breakfast and spend the morning at your own leisure.

1230hrs: Enjoy a scintillating buffet lunch at the Lodge.

Afternoon spent at leisure. You can relax by the swimming pool or you can also visit an authentic Maasai village during your game drive as per extra costs shown below;

1600hrs: Depart for an evening game drive.

1830 hrs Dinner and overnight at Mara Simba Lodge

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 6 DEPARTURE

0730hrs: Enjoy a buffet breakfast at the lodge and then check out.

Depart for Nairobi city also known as the green city under the sun

Lunch on own arrangement before drop off at JKIA Airport for your home bound flight. (3 hrs prior check-in required)

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Please note

1. Soft-sided luggage or duffels are preferable to hard luggage for storage on safari vehicles within East Africa. Large suitcases of dimensions greater than 24"x 17"x 7" are impossible to store in vehicles and on aircraft and should not be used. (Baggage and personal effects are at owner's risk throughout the tour and baggage insurance for members is strongly advised). **Luggage limit of one soft bag per person during travel in Kenya/Tanzania. Hard cases should be avoided as they cannot fit in safari vehicles**
 2. Baggage on Internal Scheduled Flights: if applicable
Baggage allowance is 15 kg per person
Extra luggage will be charged each kilo basis subject to availability of space.
 3. **Non A/C Vehicles are used for transfers in Nairobi and on Safari in Kenya & Tanzania**
 4. PASSPORT SHOULD BE VALID AT LEAST 6 MONTHS BEYOND PERIOD OF STAY.
 5. DUTY OF THE CLIENT TO CHECK VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRAVEL.
 6. CHECK-IN AT THE HOTELS ARE 1400HOURS & CHECK- OUT 1000HOURS.
