PROGRAM IN DETAIL

DAY 01 2ND MAY; ARRIVE - NAIROBI

Once you arrive at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), you'll be warmly received by HTT Operations Manager, who will give you a short brief of your safari. You will then be transferred by private vehicle to Movenpick Hotel located in the heart of Westlands, Nairobi's commercial, retail and entertainment suburb about 20 kilometers from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport.



Depending on when you arrive, you may have time to explore the city and its attractions.

Some of the most popular excursions include:-

- Visit to the Karen Blixen Museum (once home to the author of the evocative “Out of Africa” book).
- Giraffe Centre; which protects the highly endangered Rothschild's giraffe.
- David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust; an orphanage for young elephants.
- Nairobi National Park; the only wildlife national park in the world that is located within a city.

Meal Plan: Bed & Breakfast (bfast next day)

Lunch and dinner on own basis.

Overnight at Movenpick Hotel & Residences, Nairobi; **Standard rooms booked**

DAY 02 3RD MAY; NAIROBI – AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

0630 hrs Buffet breakfast at Movenpick Hotel & Residences, Nairobi

0730 hrs Depart for Amboseli national park

1230 hrs approximately, Arrive at the park gate, enroute to your lodge you will have game drive

1300 hrs Check in and enjoy your buffet mouthwatering lunch

The park is famous for being the best place in Africa to get close to free-ranging elephants among other wildlife species. Other attraction of the park includes opportunities to meet the Maasai people and also offers spectacular views of Mount Kilimanjaro, the highest free-standing mountain in the world.

The park is 39,206 hectares (392 km²; 151 sq mi) in size at the core of an 8,000 square kilometres (3,100 sq mi) ecosystem that spreads across the Kenya-Tanzania border.

1500 hrs Enjoy your first game drive, expect to see the big five and free ranging elephants

1830hrs: Return to the lodge

1930hrs-dinner and overnight stay at Amboseli Sopa Lodge– standard rooms booked

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)



DAY 03 4TH MAY; AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK – ABERDARES NATIONAL PARK

0630hrs -Enjoy a buffet breakfast at Amboseli Sopa lodge and then check out,

0730hrs -Depart for the scenic Aberdares National Park with picnic lunch boxes. You'll arrive at the Aberdares Country Club, which is the base hotel for The Ark Tree Lodge at approximately **1430hrs** for check in; thereafter you'll be transferred to The Ark.

Note: (Pack small overnight bags for the Ark).

Set in the heart of the Aberdare National Park, iconic and yes, quirky. The Ark overlooks a floodlit waterhole and salt lick, which attracts a host of awesome wildlife. Modeled after Noah's Ark, The Ark has four viewing decks with balconies and lounges to provide superb game viewing from the comfort of the lodge. The animals come to you!



Dinner and then overnight at The Ark; Standard rooms booked

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 04 5TH MAY; ABERDARES NATIONAL PARK – LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

0730hrs Wake up to a hearty buffet breakfast at the Ark. then transferred to Aberdares Country Club to reclaim your left luggage

0830hrs. – check out and depart to Lake Nakuru National Park, on your way to Lake Nakuru, you will visit Thompsons falls

MIDDAY hrs appx: Arrival at Lake Nakuru Sopa lodge in time for lunch- check in and enjoy lunch

Lake Nakuru national park is well known for Greater and Lesser Flamingo is the main attraction in the park, including other water birds approximately about 450 species in total.

Mammals: 56 different species including white Rhinos, Waterbuck etc.

1600hrs depart for evening game drive

Other Attractions includes:-

- View-points: Lion hill, Baboon cliff and Out of Africa
- Hills: Enasoit, Honeymoon, Lion hill ridge etc.
- Waterfalls: Makalia.
- Unique vegetation: About 550 different plant species including the unique and biggest euphorbia forest in Africa, Picturesque landscape and yellow acacia woodlands.

1830hrs return to lodge

1930hrs- Dinner and overnight stay at Lake Nakuru Sopa lodge; **Standard rooms booked**

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 05 6TH MAY; LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK – LAKE NAIVASHA

0630 hrs – final early morning game drive in the park

0830 hrs Return to lodge for breakfast.

1000 hrs Depart after breakfast for Lake Naivasha

1130 hrs Approximately, arrival at Lake Naivasha Country Club; check in and relax.

1230 hrs – enjoy a buffet mouthwatering lunch at the Club

Afternoon spent at leisure.

Lake Naivasha is a freshwater lake in the Kenya section of Africa’s Great Rift Valley, and is located North West of Nairobi with the town of Naivasha on its north eastern shore. At 1,890 meters (6,200 ft) above sea level, the lake is at the highest point in the Kenyan rift, and is set in a complex geological combination of volcanic rocks and sedimentary deposits from a much larger Pleistocene era lake.

Because the outlet for this ancient lake, now called Njorwa Gorge, is today much higher than the lake, the original Lake Naivasha must have indeed been a truly vast expanse of water. The gorge now forms the entrance to the Hell’s Gate National Park which, for obvious reasons, today contains some spectacular examples of water and weather-worn rock formations as well as an abundance of flora and fauna to include some extremely rare, resident breeding pairs of Lammergeyers, otherwise known as Bearded vultures.

This time can be used doing a boat ride or a visit to Crescent Island – see rates below.

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 06 7TH MAY LAKE NAIVASHA - MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

0630hrs: Wake up to buffet breakfast at Lake Naivasha Country Club and then check out

0730hrs –Depart for Masai Mara National Reserve, which is also known as the “**Jewell of Kenya**”. On your way to Masai Mara National Reserve, you will enjoy different array of views which are just priceless.

1240hrs approximately, arrive at Masai Mara National reserve; you will enjoy game drive enroute to Mara Sopa Lodge. You’ll have a sumptuous Lunch at the lodge.

1530hrs - Enjoy your first game drive in this amazing game reserve known for its wildlife.



The Masai Mara is known as one of the finest wildlife destinations in the World. There is an excellent chance of seeing the Big 5, Cheetah, Serval cat, Hyena, Bat-eared foxes, Black-backed and Side-striped jackals, Hippo, Crocodile, Baboons, Warthog, Topi, Eland, Thompson’s gazelle, Grant’s gazelle, Impala, Waterbuck, Oribi antelope, Reedbuck antelope, and Common zebra.

1830hrs: Return to the lodge

1930hrs-dinner and overnight stay at Mara Sopa Lodge– standard rooms booked

Meal plan: (Breakfast, lunch & Dinner)

DAY 07 8TH MAY; ENJOY FULL DAY AT MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

0630hrs: Wake up for a refreshing hot cup of coffee or tea. Then depart for a morning game drive to explore the Mara plains and its intriguing wildlife.

Alternatively:-

You can opt for a Hot Air Balloon Safari instead of a morning game drive. This is truly a fun and exciting way to see Africa’s landscapes and wildlife.



The trip is magical: spend about one hour floating over the Mara plains. You float in the sky, drift with the whim of the wind, overlooking the plains, just in time to experience a breathtaking sunrise and catch a bird's eye view of the reserve.

BALLOON SAFARI IS BOOKED AT EXTRA COST AS SHOWN BELOW IN OUR EXTRAS. The cost includes Balloon Safari + Out of Africa Bush Breakfast. A certificate will be presented by the pilot after the ride.

0830hrs: Return to the Lodge for a full buffet breakfast and spend the morning at your own leisure.

1230hrs: Enjoy a scintillating buffet lunch at the Lodge.

Afternoon spent at leisure. You can relax by the swimming pool or you can also visit an authentic Maasai village during your game drive as per extra costs shown below;

1600hrs: Depart for an evening game drive.

1830 hrs Dinner and overnight at Mara Sopa Lodge; – **standard rooms booked**

DAY 08 9TH MAY DEPARTURE

0730 hrs Buffet breakfast at Mara Sopa Lodge

0830 hrs Depart to Nairobi City, also known as the green city under the sun

Lunch on own arrangement before drop off at JKIA Airport for your home bound flight. (3 hrs prior check-in required)

Please note

1. Soft-sided luggage or duffels are preferable to hard luggage for storage on safari vehicles within East Africa. Large suitcases of dimensions greater than 24"x 17"x 7" are impossible to store in vehicles and on aircraft and should not be used. (Baggage and personal effects are at owner's risk throughout the tour and baggage insurance for members is strongly advised). **Luggage limit of one soft bag per person during travel in Kenya/Tanzania. Hard cases should be avoided as they cannot fit in safari vehicles**
 2. Baggage on Internal Scheduled Flights: if applicable
Baggage allowance is 15 kg per person
Extra luggage will be charged each kilo basis subject to availability of space.
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3. **Non A/C Vehicles are used for transfers in Nairobi and on Safari in Kenya & Tanzania**
4. PASSPORT SHOULD BE VALID AT LEAST 6 MONTHS BEYOND PERIOD OF STAY.
5. DUTY OF THE CLIENT TO CHECK VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRAVEL.
6. CHECK-IN AT THE HOTELS ARE 1400HOURS & CHECK- OUT 1000HOURS.
