Safari Itinerary

DAY 01: Welcome to Nairobi, Kenya's Bustling Capital

Arrival at JKIA Airport where you will be met by HTT Operations Manager, a short safari brief will be done and then handed over to your driver guide then transferred by private vehicle to Movenpick Hotel located in the heart of Westlands, Nairobi's commercial, retail and entertainment suburb about 20 kilometers from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. The hotel provides easy access to the city center and diplomatic district a perfect base to explore Kenya's capital while staying for business or leisure in 276 spacious rooms, suites and residences.

Lunch and dinner on own basis: You can have lunch/dinner at the hotel's signature restaurants that serve an array of sumptuous local and international cuisines. We can also recommend one of the several city restaurants that serve various delicious cuisines; African, Chinese, Italian, Indian and Vegetarian.

Check in time is 1400 hours. Overnight at Movenpick Hotel

Meal plan: Bed and breakfast basis



DAY 02: Maasai Mara Game Reserve, 8th Wonder of the World

0630hrs: Wake up to an early buffet breakfast at Movenpick Hotel & Residences and then check out.

0730hrs - Depart for Masai Mara National Reserve, which is also known as the “**Jewel of Kenya**”. On your way to Masai Mara National Reserve, you will enjoy different array of views which are just priceless. The drive passes via the great rift escarpment where a brief stopover will be made for photography and then continue driving. The view is just out of this world!

1240hrs appx: Arrive at Masai Mara National reserve; you will have game drive enroute to your lodge which is Keekorok Lodge. You'll have a sumptuous Lunch at the lodge.

1530 hrs - enjoy your first game drive in this amazing game reserve known for its wildlife.

1600 hrs - Evening game drive.

The Maasai Mara National Reserve is one of the most popular safari destinations in Africa. The Maasai Mara is regarded as the jewel of Kenya's wildlife viewing areas. There have been some 95 species of mammals, amphibians and reptiles and over 450 birds species recorded on the reserve.

Nowhere in Africa is wildlife more abundant, and it is for this reason a visitor hardly misses to see the big five (**buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion, and rhino**). Other animals that can be spotted here include hippos, cheetahs, gazelles, antelopes, zebras, giraffes, dik-dik, and warthogs among others.



The annual wildebeest's migration alone involves over 1.5 million wildebeests, zebras, gazelles and other animals that cross over from the Serengeti to the Maasai Mara in search of pasture and water. They cross the Mara River in July and make the return journey in late October/November. The migration, especially the Mara River crossing has been dubbed one of the 8th wonders of the modern world.

1830 hrs Return to the lodge for dinner and then overnight at Keekorok Lodge in chalet room.

DAY 03: Enjoy Captivating Full Day in the Maasai

0630 hrs Depart for a morning game drive.

0830 hrs Return to the lodge for a full buffet breakfast.

Morning spent at leisure.



1230 hrs Buffet lunch at the lodge.

Afternoon you can visit a traditional Masai Manyatta (village) to learn more of the Maasai culture and purchase their hand made local crafts, in turn supporting their existence and lifestyle within the park, **at an extra cost.**

1600 hrs Depart for an evening game drive.

1830 hrs Return to the lodge for dinner and then overnight at Keekorok Lodge.

Meal plan: FULL BOARD (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

DAY 04: from Maasai Mara to the Shores of Lake Nakuru National Park

0700 hrs - Enjoy buffet breakfast then check out.

0730 hrs - Departure towards Lake Nakuru National park.

The park's main attraction include the Greater and Lesser flamingo & other species of birds; approximately 450. The parks hosts 56 different species of mammals including the Rhinos, Lions, Zebra, Cheetahs, Leopards, Waterbucks and more.



Other Attractions includes:-

- View-points: Lion hill, Baboon cliff and Out of Africa
- Hills: Enasoit, Honeymoon, Lion hill ridge etc.
- Waterfalls: Makalia.
- Unique vegetation: About 550 different plant species including the unique and biggest euphorbia forest in Africa, Picturesque landscape and yellow acacia woodlands.

You'll arrive at Lion Hill Lodge just in time for lunch. Later in the afternoon, go on a game drive.

1830 hrs - Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 05: The Coastal City of Mombasa

0730 hrs: Buffet breakfast at the lodge. Check out and drive back to Nairobi & arrive by midday.
Drop off at Railway station for express train to Mombasa.

Train departure at 1435 hours. Arrival in Mombasa at 1918 hours.

Upon arrival in Mombasa, you'll be met by our HTT Rep and be transferred to Mombasa Serena Beach Resort. Stay is on Half Board Basis (Breakfast & Lunch/Dinner).

DAY 06: Full Day in Mombasa

You will spend the whole day at Mombasa Serena Beach Resort. There are plenty of day excursions around the city (charged at extra cost). These include the Fort Jesus, Haller Park, Mombasa Old Town, Mombasa City Tour, Bombolulu Cultural Centre, Mamba Village and the Gedi Ruins.

Dinner and Overnight at Serena Beach Resort on HB basis (breakfast and dinner).

DAY 07: Panoramic Views of Mount Kilimanjaro at Amboseli

0600hrs: Pre-booked light breakfast at Mombasa Serena Beach Resort and then check out and drop off at the railway station to board your train from Mombasa to Emali station.

Train departs at 0800 hrs (check in by 0700 hrs)

Arrival at email at 1205 hrs

Upon arrival at the station met by your driver/guide and transfer to Amboseli National park.

Amboseli National Park is famous for being the best place in Africa to get close to free-ranging elephants. Other attractions include spectacular views of Mount Kilimanjaro, the highest free-standing mountain in the world and opportunities to meet the Maasai people. The park is also home to lions, cheetahs, buffalos, giraffes, zebras, wildebeests and impalas among others.



Arrival for late lunch at the lodge and check in. Afternoon enjoy game drive in the park.

Dinner and then overnight at Amboseli Sopa Lodge.

DAY 08: Explore the Wonders of Amboseli National Park

0730 hrs – After a buffet breakfast, depart for a full day game drive with picnic lunch.



You can enjoy plenty of attractions here including:-

- Panoramic views of Mount Kilimanjaro, the highest freestanding mountain in the world.
- Meet the Maasai people and learn about the Maasai culture and their indigenous lifestyle.
- Visit Observation Hill, which allows an overall view of the whole park especially the swamps and elephants.

1830 hrs - Return to the lodge for dinner and then overnight at Amboseli Sopa Lodge.

DAY 09: from Amboseli to Nairobi & Onwards

0700hrs: Enjoy a buffet breakfast at the lodge, check out and head back to Nairobi and drop off at JKI Airport for your flight back home. **Please note:** (3 hours prior check in required for international flight departures)
